

## Magic Knight's Tours : Update to sources given in *Variant Chess* 57

JDB reporting work by George Jelliss, 16 July 2017

The sources given in the catalogue of magic knight's tours in issue 57 of *Variant Chess* relied heavily on manuscript 106 in the H. J. R. Murray papers in the Bodleian Library. George Jelliss has now examined much of the source material personally, and has reported in his "Jeepyjay" blog

in most cases citing not merely source document and year of publication but also issue and page or item number. In the light of this, the list of sources on page 51 of *VC* 57 needs correction.

- **6-9** (Shri Krishna Udayar): George has a note that the silk is now in the Crumiller collection.
- **53** (Wenzelides): The date should be 1850.

The sources of **81** (Bouvier), **127, 134, 135** (Exner), **34-35** (anonymous), **10-13, 83, 129, 85, 86, 106** (Francony), **22-25** (Ligondès), **123...126** (Reuss), **107** (Ligondès), **68** (Grossetaite), **30-33, 110, 111** (Ligondès), and **94** (Lehmann) have not been seen by George. In all other cases, "(Murray)" should now be replaced by "(Jelliss)".

The headings of some of the items in the catalogue on pages 52-53 also need to be changed.
